Meeting with Insurance Board

President CA. Prakash Jung Thapa along with Vice President CA. Jagannath Upadhyay (Niraula) and Executive Director CA. Sanjay Kumar Sinha had a meeting with officials of Insurance Board to discuss effective implementation of NFRS in Insurance sector on 1st April, 2018. The meeting focused on support to be extended by Institute for effective implementation of NFRS by insurance companies. The Insurance Board assured to get NFRS implemented by insurance companies and to provide the required support to insurance companies and in this regard a committee has been formed to monitor the progress of implementation.

Notice Served for Quality Assurance Review

The Office of Election Officer has published final voters list for upcoming 8th Council Election. As per the list, 1145 <u>chartered accountants</u> and 3420 <u>registered auditors</u> are listed as voters.

National News

NRB allows borrowing from foreign banks

Nepal Rastra Bank (NRB), central bank of Nepal, releasing a Notice on Chaitra 20, 2074 has paved way for commercial banks to borrow from foreign banks and financial Institutions. As per the notice, commercial banks maintaining the prescribed capital fund can borrow in foreign currency maximum 25 % of their primary capital fund for extending credit in sector of hydropower generation and transmission, road, tunnel, foreign currency earning tourism sector, infrastructure (except housing and real-estate), agriculture, micro credit etc. However, such funds are restricted

for interbank lending, subject to limitation of interest rates up to 6-month Libor + 3 % and no levy of fees and commission on extending credit from such fund. However, availing credit facility from foreign bank and financial institution continues to be subject to approval from NRB.

International News

Influential Leader Sought for IAASB Chair

The global search is underway for an exceptional individual to lead the International Auditing and Assurance Standards Board (IAASB) into its next era.

The IAASB Chair is appointed for a renewable three-year term, commencing January 1, 2019. A complete job description, along with application instructions, is available on the IAASB website. Applications are due May 20.

Global Ethics Board Releases Revamped Code of Ethics for Professional Accountants

The International Ethics Standards Board for Accountants[®] (IESBA[®]) released a completely rewritten **Code of Ethics** for Professional Accountants that is easier to navigate, use and enforce. Beyond the new structure, the Code brings together key ethics advances over the past four years and is clearer about how accountants should deal with ethics and independence issues.

International Accounting Education Standards Board Seeks New Volunteer Chair

The International Accounting Education Standards Board (IAESB) is seeking its next volunteer Chair for a renewable three-year term beginning January 1, 2019.

The IAESB Chair leads a board of volunteer members in setting international standards for accounting education. These high-quality standards and related guidance set forth the principles that strengthen the professional competence, skills, and values for accountants' initial and continuing professional development.

Patchwork Financial Regulation: a \$780 Billion Drag on the Economy

Fragmentation in global financial regulation costs more than USD \$780 billion annually, according to a survey released by IFAC (International Federation of Accountants) and *Business at OECD* (BIAC). The survey, *Regulatory Divergence: Costs, Risks, Impacts: An International Financial Sector Study*, examines the cost of regulatory divergence by taking the pulse of more than 250 regulatory and compliance leaders from major global financial institutions. The results quantify the massive impact of fragmented regulation: material economic costs, financial system risk, and barriers to economic growth.
